We will be playing in the Indianapolis Convention Center hall way near one of the large entrances. Our schedule will be printed in the program and we will also have it on our table in the Exhibit Hall. We can be found with all of the other stars on Autograph Avenue. Last year it was the likes of Kevin Sorbo ("Hercules" and "Andromeda"), Jamie Bamber (The current Apollo in the current "Battlestar Galactica"), Richard Hatch (Tom Zareek on the Current BG and the original Apollo on the original BG) and the Build Team from "Myth Busters"! If you're going to be in Indianapolis and you're into any kind of gaming, (on line, video, cards, board games, you name it) this is the place to be August 16th - 19th. ## Heading East, then West

The Muses are heading east for the early fall. We'll be touring through Indianapolis, IN performing at Gen Con Indy, and several libraries in the area. Then we are off to Illinois for 6 days of recuperation (and rehearsal). If anyone in the Galena, IL area is interested in a Home Grown House Concert August 26th - 31st, please let us know ASAP so we can set it up. After that we're in Northern Ohio for 6 days, then it's off to New York. We'll be in the Rochester area, Syracuse, and Albany. Then we head for Massachusetts. We'll be performing for the Amazing Things Arts Center [www.amazingthings.org](http://www.amazingthings.org) on September 22nd. Keep an eye on our calendar for other shows in Mass. After that we head to Kentucky to play for libraries who had us in last year, then we head for Carbondale, IL to play at Cousin Andy's Coffeehouse on September 28th.

After a short break at home, we're heading for Arizona and California again. We'll be at the Tucson Celtic Festival for the third time as well as several places around the Phoenix area including the Celtic Café at the Irish Cultural Center of Arizona on November 9th. We are also lucky enough to have a Home Grown House Concert scheduled in Tucson on November 8th. We head for California on November 11th and will be there through Thanksgiving. We'll be playing such notable places as The Coffee Gallery Backstage November 16th, [www.coffeegallery.com](http://www.coffeegallery.com), Green Acres Lavender Farm November 24th [www.greenacreslavenderfarm.com](http://www.greenacreslavenderfarm.com) and several area libraries. After the Thanksgiving Holiday, we'll be headed up the West Coast. We have another Home Grown House Concert in San Francisco, then we are going to Oregon, Washington, and Sand Point, Idaho. Then home for the holidays for us before the serious snows set in.
